# DASHBOARD

## How to Access and Customize your Dashboard

The **Dashboard** offers you a current, summarized snapshot view of your farm, equipment, weather, notifications, jobs, etc. The information is displayed in groupings called tiles.

Organize the tiles to accommodate your information preferences.

First, select the **Farm** and **Season** to filter the information displayed.

Second, select what information tiles you want displayed in your Dashboard by clicking Settings (⚙️) and selecting or deselecting the tiles from the list.

Third, click Navigation (⊕) to unlock the tiles. Drag and drop the tiles in the arrangement and order you want to view them.
